Individuals who volunteer to help with event setup and/or tear down may set up their camp as early as Monday, April 21st, but no earlier. No early arrivals permitted unless you are volunteering and have received confirmation of that. The work parties will begin on Tuesday at 9 AM, when we will meet at the dining fly by Capt. Wort's store. A member of the Market Fair Committee will be there to go over assignments.

There will be a mandatory volunteer meeting on Tuesday, April 22, at 4:30 pm under the large dining fly beside Capt. Wort's store. We will be talking about what's new, review procedures, the weather, contact information and the usual Market Fair issues as well as answering questions. We will also review task lists to confirm volunteers for specific tasks. After the meeting, Market Fair Committee members will be there to get you registered.
